As global efforts to manage the COVID-19 pandemic continue, it is important to take stock of the state of childhood TB and evaluate what needs to be done, not just to reach the rate of progress that existed prior to the pandemic, but to advance efforts on multiple fronts to reduce morbidity and mortality from TB in children.

This webinar will be dedicated to discussing five articles published in the supplement of the Journal of the Paediatric Infectious Diseases Society "What's New in Childhood Tuberculosis?" where experts in childhood TB address several aspects of the TB epidemic in children. These articles identify the challenges in controlling childhood TB in 2022 and beyond, and highlight areas that can accelerate the prevention, diagnosis, and treatment of this longstanding global pandemic.
