SIGN THE DOTTED LINE

1. DIAGNOSTICS

- → No out-of-pocket expenditures for TB tests
- ---> Rapid molecular test (i.e. Xpert) is initial diagnostic for all
- ---> Second-line drug susceptibility testing is available

2. MODELS OF CARE

- → Treatment initiation: TB at primary level,
 DRTB at district/below
- ---> Compulsory hospitalisation is not required
- ---> Immediate ART is offered to people living with HIV

3. DRUG REGULATION

- ---> NTP procures quality-assured TB drugs
- ---> Prescriptions are required for all TB drugs (not over-the-counter)
- ---> TB drugs benefit from accelerated registration

4. DS-TB TREATMENT

- ---> Daily fixed-dose combinations is standard of care
- ---> Treatment, including for children, reflect WHO guidance
- ---> TB contacts are screened, children & PLWHA receive IPT

5. DR-TB TREATMENT

- → DR-TB treatment reflects WHO guidance
- ---> WHO recommended DR-TB drugs are on national EML
- ---> New drugs are available via import waivers until full registration
